Structure

1. **Open Source License Name**
 - The OS License used by one or several components.
2. **Component Name and Artifact Id**
 - The component using dependencies with the current OS License.
3. **Dependencies**
 - The list of dependencies which required the use of the licenses.
4. **Collapse controls**
 - Controls to show or hide component lists or dependencies lists.
