

# Publish to Kinesis How to Configure

## Step 1. Launch Aspire and open the Content Source Management page

Launch Aspire (if not already running). See:


## Step 2. Add a new content source

For this step, follow the step from the Configuration Tutorial of the connector of your choice, please refer to [Connector list](#).

## Step 3. Add a new Publish to Kinesis to the workflow

To add a Publish to Kinesis, drag from the **Publish to Kinesis** rule from the *Workflow Library* and drop to the *Workflow Tree* where you want to add it. This will automatically open the Publish to Kinesis window for the configuration of the publisher.

1. **Enter AWS account credentials**
  - a. Access Key
  - b. Secret Key
2. **Enter the stream details**
  - a. Stream Name
  - b. Region (e.g. us-west-1, see [AWS Regions and Endpoints](#))
3. **JSON Transformation**
  - a. If checked, Aspire will use a Groovy script to perform custom JSON transformation. To use a custom file, follow the instructions in [JSON Transformation](#)
